


- a. Choose the county in the drop down box below the first blank. This is where you are filing the Petition. This <u>must</u> be the county in which you are living.


The numbers below give instructions for completing the paragraphs with the same numbers in the Petition. Paragraph 1.

- e. Check the next box ONLY if you do not speak English and enter the language that you speak in the blank.





- g. Enter your mailing address if different from your physical address.





- i. If you agree to receive e-mails from the court, provide your full e-mail address in the blank provided and read the statement of understanding.





j. Enter the name(s) and address(es) of your parent(s) if known.





k. If your parent(s) are not your legal guardian(s), enter the name(s) and address(es) of your legal guardian(s) if known.





 If you cannot find either your parent(s) or legal guardian(s), enter the name(s) and address(es) of your nearest known relative that lives in Nebraska, if there are any.




Paragraph 7.

- n. If you answered that you are part of a case, use the blanks to enter the type of court, the county and state where the case is at and the case number if you know them.




