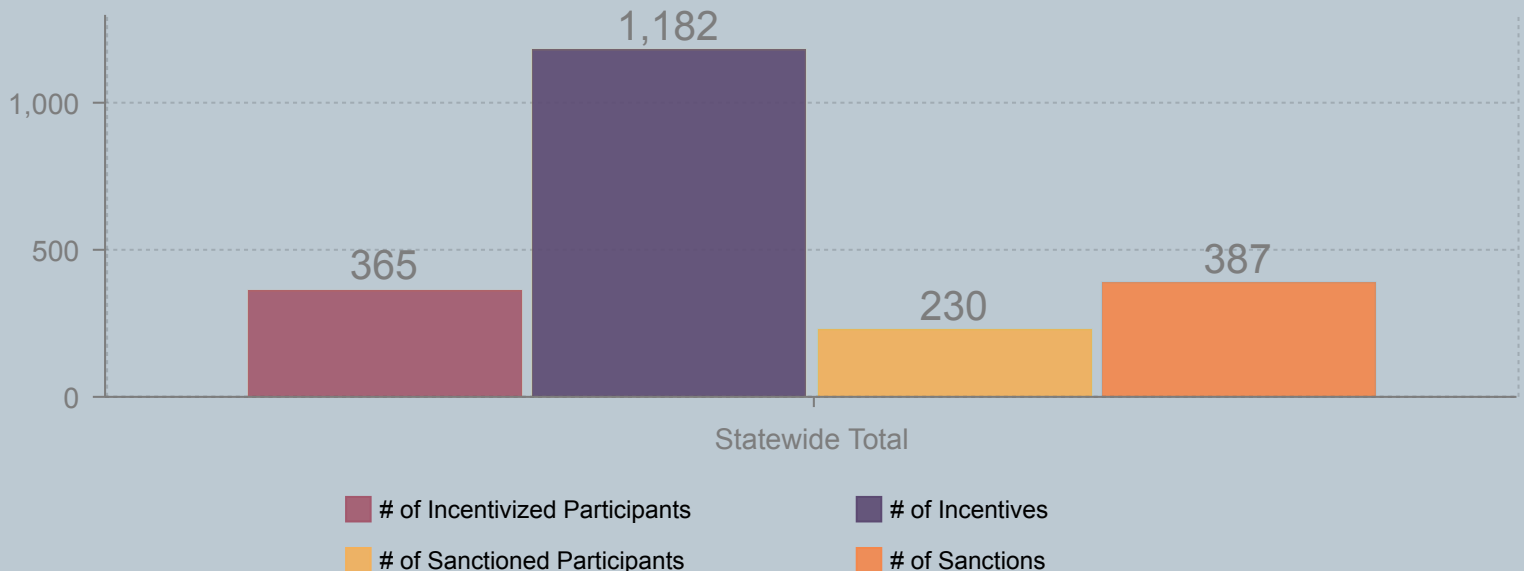

# PSC Risk Reduction

January 1 - March 31, 2020

*Initial Risk* score on 1st LS/CMI and *decrease* in the average LS/CMI score between a graduated adult's first and last assessment.



*Initial Risk* score on 1st YLS/CMI and *decrease* in the average YLS/CMI score between a graduated youth's first and last assessment.

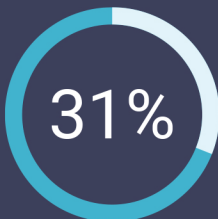
